




Pearson SuccessNet – Parents & Students

<p>Navigate to https://www.pearsonsuccessnet.com</p> <p>Enter your student's username (This is your student's 6-digit FID ID number)</p> <p>Enter your student's password (This is your student's 6-digit birthdate in the mmddyy format)</p> <p>Click Log In</p>	
<p>If prompted,</p> <p>Enter your school's zip code</p> <p>Select your school from the list</p> <p>Click Log in</p>	
<p>Your student's home page will be displayed. (Different grade level home pages will look slightly different; however, the same resources will be available.)</p> <p>From here you can access resources that have been assigned to your student. Resources will vary by student. Some of the tools you might see:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 1-Online textbook 2-Student textbook resources 3-Leveled Readers 4-Online resources 5-Logout button 	

Some tools available with the online text:

- 1-Collapsible navigation area
