Reader's and Writer's Workshop

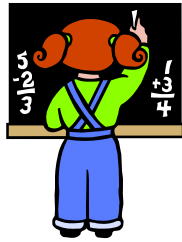
Reading: We will be introducing the "Fab 4" reading comprehension strategy by Lori D. Oczkus.

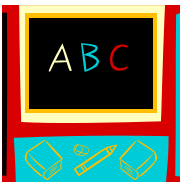
