What Are We Learning Next Week?

Math: We will be identifying, creating and extending patterns.

Reader's Workshop: We will be talking about the color **black**. We will be introducing plot. We will also talk about predicting and inferring and how knowing about these strategies help us become better readers.

Language Arts: We will learn the letter Z and then review all of our starting corner capitals (H, K, L, U, V, W, X, Y, Z). We will continue stretching sounds and writing the letters to make a word. We will be talking about the organization of our writing and the importance of sequencing our sentences and our words within the sentence to make sure that they make sense.
