## What Are We Learning Next Week?

**Math:** We will be constructing patterns.

**Reader's Workshop:** We will be talking about the color **white**. We will continue talking about the plot of a story as well as the reading strategies inferring, predicting and visualizing. We will start talking about the setting of a story and why it is important.

**Language Arts:** We will learn the letters C, O and Q. We will be talking about the organization of a sentence and why it is important to put the words in the correct order. We will also continue working on hearing the beginning sounds in words.
