7:20 - 7:50 ~ Drop off in the cafeteria

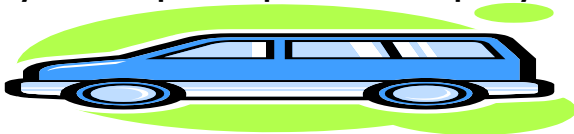
After 7:50 ~ Walk straight to classroom
