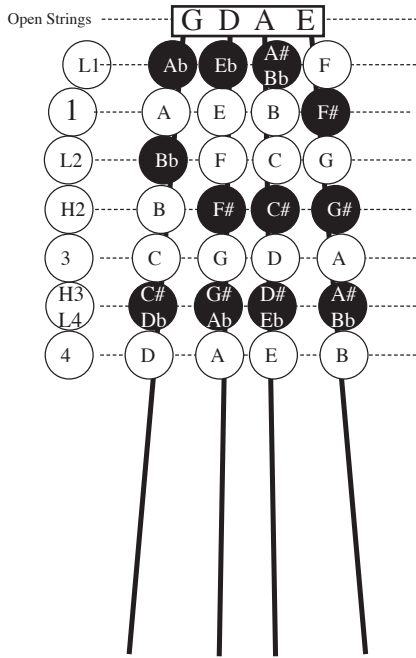
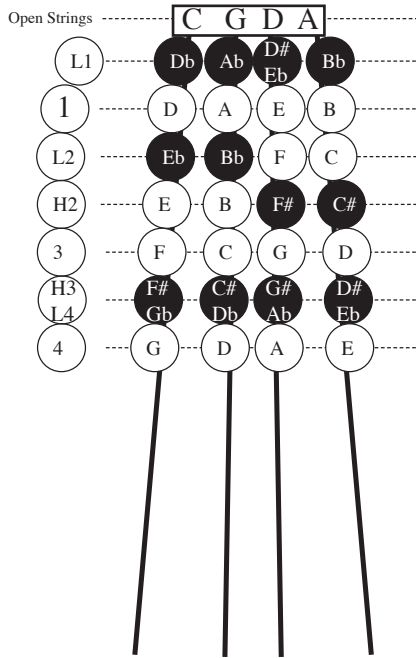

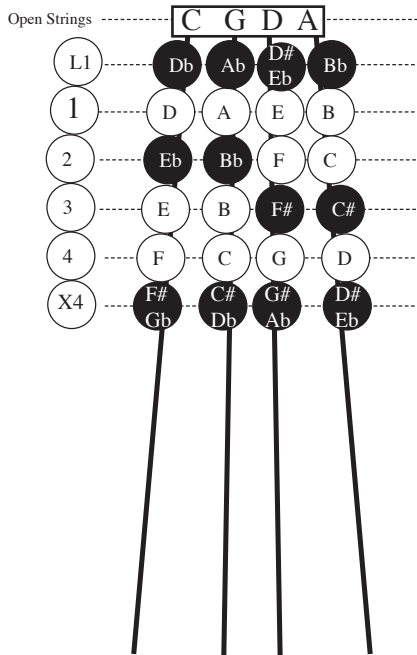


ENHARMONIC: Notes that are written differently but sound the same.

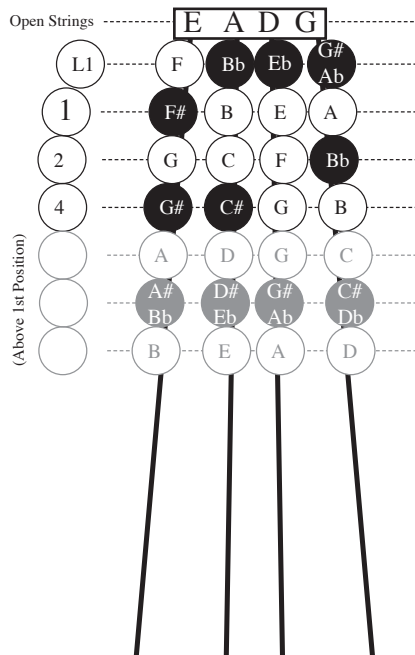
They are:

Question: What does "D.C. al fine" mean? (Answer: "D.C." = "Da capo" = "The head" means: go back to the beginning, "al fine" = "until finish" = play until you reach "fine")

Question: What does "D.S. al coda" mean? (Answer: "D.S." = "dal segno" = "the sign" means: Go back to the sign (♯) and then jump to the coda at the (⊕) coda sign)

A "C" in the time signature stands for "common time", which is the same as 4/4 time.
