**Students are expected to bring appropriate materials every class day whether we use them or not.**

Class Rules:

**Class begins when the tardy bell rings and does not end until I release you. Not when the bell rings.**

**GRADING POLICY:**

**Daily Assignments            40%**

**Projects/Labs                20%**

**Tests                            25%**

**Six Weeks Test                15%**

**Total                            100%**

**All assignments are expected to be turned in on time. On time is at the beginning of class before the tardy bell. If not, the following penalties will apply:**

**0 days late: 10% deduction if turned in after the tardy bell, but before the next day**

**1 day late: 20% deduction if turned in the following school day**

**2 days late: 30% deduction if turned in the next time you have my class**

**3 days late: 50% deduction**

**After 3 days: not accepted**

**Notice these are DAYS not CLASS DAYS. For instance if you have a homework assignment due on Tuesday and you give it to me late the highest you can receive is a 90%; 1 day late (Wednesday) the highest you can receive is 80%; 2 days late (Thursday) the highest you can receive is 70%**

**Tardy Policy:**

Students reporting to class late without a proper pass will be marked as tardy unexcused. This includes coming from another class. **If you are tardy, you must get a pass from the tardy machine.** No hand written notes from other teachers will be accepted. Also, if you are not in your seat when the bell rings you will be marked tardy unexcused.

**Making up tests:**

You will have **2 days** from the date of your absence to get with me to makeup your missed test. If you fail to make it up within the allotted time frame you will receive a grade of 1-5 for that test.

**Retesting:**

If you fail a test you will be allowed to retest over the same material, not the same test. The retest will be given with the six weeks test. The highest grade that can be received on a retest is 70.
