Missoula Children's Theatre

An audition will be held for the Missoula Children's Theatre (MCT) production of KING ARTHUR'S QUEST Monday, March 14th at LTES from 3:30 to 5:30 for all K-8 Dieringer School District students. Those auditioning must return a completed permission slip to the school by Friday, March 11th. A detailed flyer with permission slip will be sent home soon. There will be 50-60 roles cast. Some of the cast members will be asked to stay for a rehearsal immediately following the audition. Parents will need to provide transportation home.

Among the roles to be cast are King Arthur, Guinevere, Merlin, Raven, Taliesin, Lancelot, the Knights, the Squires, the Camelotians, the Lady of the Lake, Mordred, Morgan Le Fey, Uther Pendragon, the Damsels and the Minis. All students, grades Kindergarten through 8th Grade, are encouraged to audition. No advance preparation is necessary. Assistant Directors will also be cast to assist with the technical aspects of the production.

The Missoula Children's Theatre touring productions are complete with costumes, scenery, props and makeup. MCT Tour Actor/Directors will conduct rehearsals throughout the week from 3:30 to 5:30 and 6:00 to 8:00 each day (Not all cast members are required for all rehearsals).
